



## Novo Nordisk Postdoctoral and Clinical Research Training Fellowships



We are currently recruiting three Postdoctoral Research Fellows and one Clinical Research Training Fellow as part of the Novo Nordisk fellowship programme at the University of Oxford.

Applications are invited from basic scientists and clinicians wishing to undertake research with a focus on diabetes. Each fellowship is fully funded for three years. These prestigious fellowships are open to outstanding candidates of any nationality.

Please note that the funding provided for the Clinical Research Training Fellowship will only cover home/EU PhD (DPhil) fees.

- **Postdoctoral Research Fellowship: Grade 7:** £29,837- £36,661, with a discretionary range to £40,046 per annum
- Clinical Research Training Fellowship: Grade E64: £31,301 – £50,167 per annum
